Here is the "music" for Twinkle Variation 1. It's the same as the "Rabbit Habitat," if you want to use that chart. It gets a "motorcycle stop-stop" with the bow on every note. Please stop in between notes to prepare for the next note:

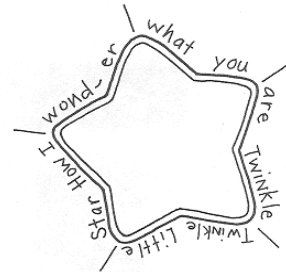
NEW: **Twinkle Variation 1: first part**

Play motorcycle stop-stop rhythm on each note that's in bold:

A **E** **1** **E**

Place 1-2-3 on A string, rock to A string

3 **2** **1** **A**
